

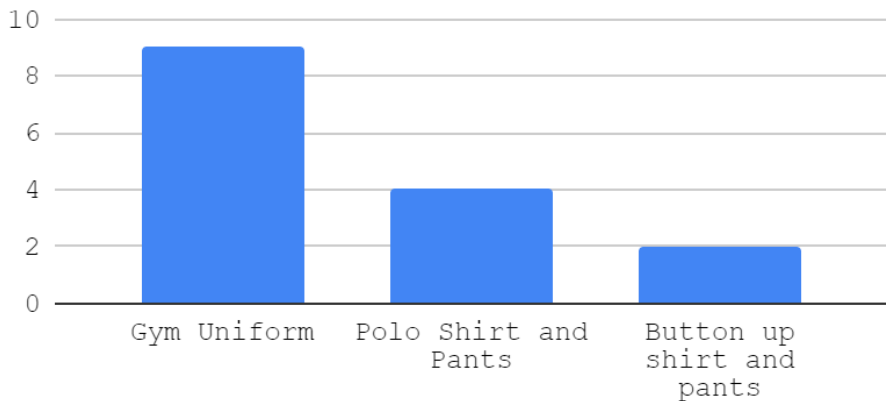
Academics

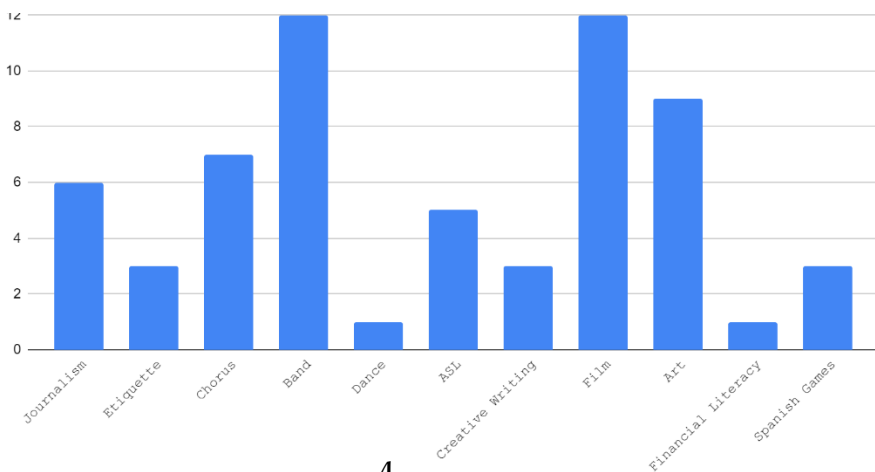

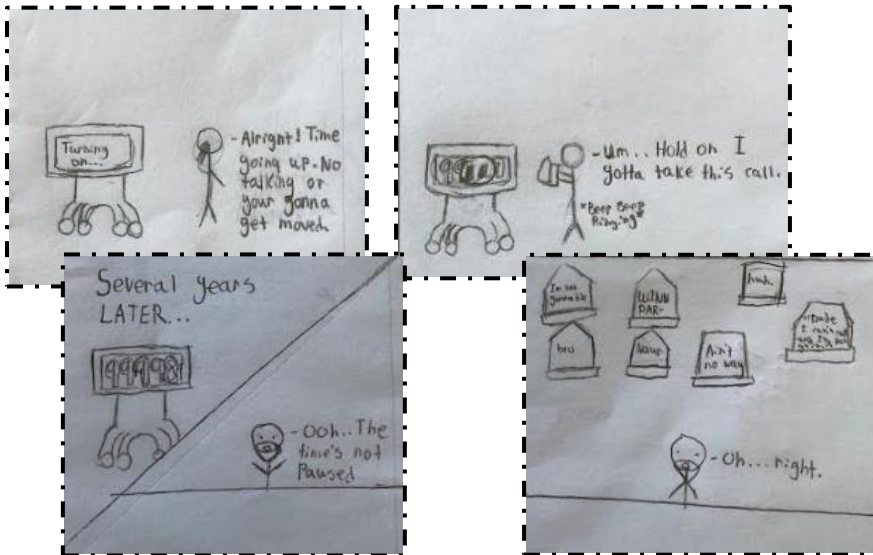


Sawyer Troché, 6th Grade
