NUT CARD/FIELD TRIP DRESS GUIDELINES

Cleanliness, neatness, appropriateness, modesty, and effect on the learning environment are the criteria that should dictate the student's choice of dress and grooming when attending field trips or enjoying a NUT card day.

Students and their parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that modesty, appropriateness and neatness of dress are maintained. In order to avoid disappointment we have provided a list of unacceptable attire for field trips or NUT card days.

Please do not wear the following items to school:

- **HATS** Headgear of any kind including bandannas, head rags or hats of any type while in the school building
- **SHOES** Flip flops, shoe skates, house slippers, high heels or other hazardous footwear
- **SHIRTS** Spaghetti straps, tank or tube tops, halters, midriff tops.

Shirts that exceed fingertip length when arms are by the side (for boys only)

SHORTS Pants or shorts above normal body size or sagging pants of any kind. Pants or short must be on hips at all times
Pajama pants
Short-shorts or cut-offs. Place hands at your sides. If your shorts do not reach your fingertips, they are too short.

DRESSES Dresses or skirts shorter than approximately 1" above the knee **OR SKIRTS**

Please do not wear the following:

- Sunglasses
- Clothing with slits or tears or pants with unpatched holes
- Tight or revealing clothing
- See-through clothing or visible undergarments
- Dressing without appropriate undergarments
- Any clothing that advertises or depicts products, alcoholic beverages, drugs or any other substances that students are prohibited from having or using at school.
- Any clothing that is lewd, offensive, vulgar or obscene
- Any clothing or grooming that depicts crime, violence, gang association, or occult images
- Any clothing that inappropriately exposes the body
- Heavy jewelry

Dressy-casual is always appropriate!
